

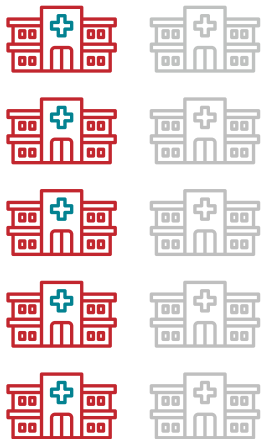
COALITION **AGAINST** SURPRISE MEDICAL BILLING

A Small Number of Hospitals Drive Surprise Medical Billing



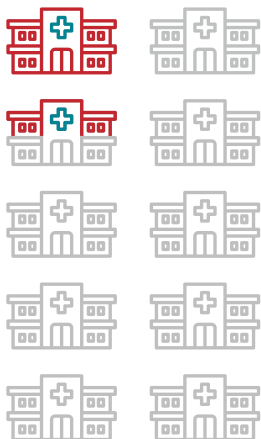
Surprise medical bills represent a major affordability challenge for millions of families because a small, but significant, number of out-of-network providers, increasingly owned by private equity groups, choose to hit patients at their most vulnerable.

According to a 2018 report from researchers at Yale University:



50% of hospitals
send surprise medical bills to
less than 2%
of emergency department patients

while



15% of hospitals
send surprise medical bills to
more than 80%
of emergency department patients
